



How to Measure Your Horse to Choose the Correct Cradle Headstall Size

1. Take your savvy string and measure from one corner of the mouth, around the poll, and to the other corner of the mouth.



2. Hold the string against a tape to check the length of your measurement. *Repeat these steps three times and use the average of the three results.*



3. Choose your headstall size*.

40" - 43" = Small

43" - 46" = Medium

46" - 49" = Large

49" - 52" = Extra Large

** If the measurement is between two sizes, we recommend going with the smaller size because the leather will stretch slightly over time.*
